



Diplomat Haïti at AYIMUN from May 27th to 30th, 2022

The maintenance of international peace and security is at the heart of the responsibilities of the United Nations. Indeed, the 51 countries gathered at the San Francisco conference held from April 25 to June 26, 1945 all had this overriding concern to create an international organization that can preserve international peace and security. In circumstances where the UN has been unable to prevent and avoid a conflict between several parties, they must restore peace and security and prevent any escalation of the conflict that could lead to an international conflict. All actions of members of the United Nations must serve this single cause, the oath made in the preamble of the Charter of the United Nations, to protect present and future generations from the scourge of war. Thus, to meet its mission, the United Nations Security Council had to apply coercive measures against Russia following the military invasion of Ukraine on February 23th, 2022.

Haiti being one of the signatories of the United Nations Charter, being the first independent black people, having been the victim of exploitation and colonization for two centuries remains and remains a supporter of peace, security, and sovereignty. In this sense, the Republic of Haiti condemned Russia's invasion of Ukraine in a vote on March 2, 2022 and voted on March 24 of the same year for unhindered humanitarian access and the protection of civilians in Ukraine. Haiti's position is clear. This Russia-Ukraine war further accentuates the misery that the Haitian population faces. The Haitian economy has not been spared from soaring oil and wheat prices on the international market. Faced with the distress of Ukrainian civilians, the harmful consequences of this conflict on the rest of the world, and the risks to which international peace and security are exposed, it is urgent to stop this armed conflict and restore peace between the two parties. However, Haiti notes that the way used by the Security Council has not been the best since it closes its eyes to the causes of the disputes between Russia and Ukraine, and seeks at all costs to humiliate Russia in the search for a solution.

Considering the responsibilities of the Security Council and the main mission of the United Nations, Considering the observation of flaws in the mediation process for the resolution of conflicts between Ukraine and Russia, Considering the first years of the young Haitian nation in the face of threats of a possible invasion of settlers, the Republic of Haiti proposes the following resolutions to put an end to the Ukraine-Russia war.

1. Respect NATO's commitments to Russia
2. Exclude any behavior and any decision that could give the perception that this is a war between the West and Russia
3. Assist civilians
4. Seek agreements between Russia and Ukraine on the basis of the supposed risk to which Russia thinks it is exposed
