**TOPIC: Russia - Ukraine CRISIS** 

Qatar has always been a country that defends human rights all over the world and has been an important ally to countries seeking freedom from any unhuman interventions by other countries. When speaking before the 49th session of the Human Rights Council in Geneva, Doha's top diplomat Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman Al Thani stressed Qatar's "respect for Ukraine's sovereignty, independence, and territorial integrity within its internationally recognised borders.

It has also had negative repercussions at all levels, namely the human and economic level.

The UN said that 227 civilians in Ukraine have been killed and 525 have been injured since the start of the invasion. The agency believes that the total civilians casualties is believed to be "considerably higher"

Europe's clamouring for liquefied natural gas, or LNG, comes after Qatar started a \$30 billion project to boost its exports by 60% by 2027. The extra demand means more competition among buyers for long-term supply contracts and, most likely, better terms for Qatar.

Qatar has the same position as most of countries in the world, despite the fact that 35 countries abstained from voting at the UN General Assembly, more than 140 had the same vision as Qatar deploring in the strongest terms Russia's invasion of Ukraine.

Nonetheless, this cannot be applied to all of the nations of the world, as many have not been blessed with the same wise leadership of the brains power, what could be even more devastating, is having a neighbour that seeks taking your land, and depriving your people from their basic rights of simply surviving. Standing here today, Qatar is urging each and every nation of the world, to support the legitimate right of Ukraine to get rid of the unnecessary invasion of Russia. Regardless of the reasons that led to the current situation that can only be described as disastrous, we should be hand in hand helping the people of this nation to rise again from the aches they have been unfairly put under. The citizens of the world, the leaders and everyone sensible human being would only feel guilt as every single day passes by without being able to stop this war. In a world of differences, let's for once find a common ground to agree that the Qatari noble message of peace is what we need to be united again as peaceful citizens of a peaceful world.
