ARGENTINA

The Russian-Ukraine crises started officially on 24th of February 2022, However this is not a sudden or unexpected invasion and there has been increasing tension between both countries ever since the breakdown of USSR. Although this has worsened since Russias annexation of Crimea and the newly formed NATO has been expanding East words and therefore Russia felt threatened.

Argentina has condemned this invasion in all its forms, the military operations and invasion is believed to be a violation of the territorial integrity of Ukraine.

During the 49th session of the UN Human Rights council in Geneva, Switzerland. Argentina made it clear that although the international community cannot outrightly put off the security concerns of Another Nation; Russia in this regard, war and use of force to violate territorial integrity of other state is not the best means of conflict resolution, rather a reasonable negotiation should be made by both parties.

Argentina finds the disturbance of world peace and loss of lives to the war of great concern. It is believed that the peace of a single country is the peace of the world and it is important to have it maintained and sustained. Due to Globalization, the effect of the war is believed to come with consequences such as economic sabotage.

Argentina has proposed a round table discussion and negotiation to ensure an end to the war which will be satisfactory to both parties and to the world at large. It believes that conflict resolution can be done without the loss of lives and destruction of properties, which will ultimately lead to hunger, and destabilization of the world at large.
